





CONTRACT



STATEMENT

This contract acts as an agreement between Parikiaki Limited and you the exhibitor, charity, company or group of companies exhibiting at the event.

Lee Valley Athletic Centre staff, Parikiaki staff and volunteers as well as other exhibitors must be treated with the utmost respect. Violence of any kind will not be tolerated. The building itself is otherwise used as an athletics centre and must ALWAYS be treated with respect; any damage or vandalism shall be treated very seriously, and the authorities will be called.

TERMINOLOGY

For the purposes of this document, you the exhibitor shall be referred to as 'YOU' as this is an agreement between YOU and the organisers Parikiaki Limited. Lee Valley Athletics Centre shall be referred to as LV.

Hereafter the Cypriot Wine Festival & Business Expo shall be referred to as the CWF+BE.

The area YOU as an exhibitor are hiring from Parikiaki Limited shall be referred to as your pitch.

Parikiaki Limited shall be referred to as Parikiaki.

DATES AND TIMES

The CWF+BE will be from Saturday 6th June - Sunday 7th June 2020

Friday 5th June - YOU will set up from 14:00 - 19:00

Saturday 6th June- YOU will have 1 hour and 30 minutes to set up, from 10:00 - 11:30 (doors will open to the

public at 12:00).

Sunday 7th June – YOU will have 1 hour to set up, from 10:00 – 11:00 (doors will open to the public at 11.30).

Monday 8th June – YOU will have access to the premises from 09:00 – 14:00 to collect any of your property.

PAYMENT

Once your interest has been registered and a pitch selected, YOU will be required to give a deposit to secure it, which will be refundable up until Monday 2nd April 2020, thereafter your deposits will be non-refundable. However, if exhibitors wish to change the pitch, the deposit sum will be transferable provided your required pitch is not occupied.

The required deposit shall be calculated at 25% of the total cost including any extras requested.

Exactly 1 month later, by Tuesday 1st May 2020, full payment is due, and the funds must be deposited either in the Parikiaki bank account or if settled by cash or cheque, make sure the monies have been received by Parikiaki by the above date. YOU will be given written notice as a reminder of payment and it must be supplied by the closing of business at 17:00 on the 1st May.

Once a contract has been signed it is legally binding between Parikiaki, CWF+BE and YOU. If cancellation is requested by YOU after Monday 2nd April and the contract has been signed, YOU will be required to pay the outstanding amount in FULL.

YOU will be supplied with an invoice less the deposit paid, which you may pay by cash, card or by cheque payable to Parikiaki Limited. If cheques bounce or card transactions are declined for whatever reason, this will count as non-payment and your securement of the booking shall be invalid until the necessary funds have been successfully paid.

Your possessions and other assets will be protected overnight by the CWF+BE security team and some CCTV coverage provided by LV, you are ultimately responsible for any loss or damage to your own property. YOU must be mindful not to damage any property, stocks or any other assets that belong to LV as you will be fully liable for the outstanding costs of either replacing or repairing the damaged items or property.

YOU acknowledge and accept that the CWF+BE provides a platform for trade between YOU and members of the public as well as between other vendors. YOU accept that free and fair competition is encouraged by the CWF+BE and exhibitors may encounter similar products and services being provided to visitors.

Tablecloths are to be returned at the end of the Expo. Failure to do so will incur an extra charge of £35 per tablecloth. It is your liability to return any other items provided to YOU as part of having a stand at the CWF+BE at the end of the event. Failure to do so may also incur extra charges

Helium balloons are not permitted in the hall.

YOU accept that any photographs or video footage taken during the event of your business may be used by the CWF+BE in advertising or promotional material including social media.

Any extra costs incurred by the CWF+BE due to non-compliance with any of the terms of this contract will be charged back to YOU and your business.

SET UP, BREAKDOWN AND HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

YOU will be issued with a hard copy of set up and breakdown times as well as a reminder of LV and Parikiaki - CWF+BE health & Safety policies, which must be complied with at all times during the event. YOU and your staff are required to wear your allocated wristbands at all times for security reasons.

To exhibit at our event, YOU will be required to:

- · Complete an Induction Form
- · Ensure you have public liability insurance valid for exhibitions for the dates specified in this contract.
- Complete all necessary Risk Assessments

It is the responsibility of YOU as an exhibitor to ensure that electrical appliances/equipment used are PAT tested and/or Gas safe certified and that if applicable any ingredients and equipment used in catering are compliant with food hygiene, Health & Safety standards. Relevant documentation must be provided to the CWF+BE using the contact details in this booklet at least 21 days prior to the event.

REFUSE DISPOSAL

It is your job as exhibitor to ensure that YOU have adequate cleaning equipment necessary and refuse bags prior to entering the grounds. Although LV provide a cleaning service they are not responsible for your company's discarded stock, leaflets etc. If you are dealing with perishable goods you must ensure that they are disposed of hygienically and any organic matter does not leave any stains in and around your pitch.

SECURITY

LV oversee the overall security of the venue and their team works in conjunction with any other security firms that Parikiaki/CWF+BE employs to protect YOU, invited VIPs, celebrities and the general public.

LV has some CCTV coverage in and around the grounds. You accept that in the event of an incident, footage (where available) will be used as evidence.

THE AGREEMENT

YOU agree to the terms and conditions set out in this document, YOU are fully aware of the content of the agreement and the consequences, should you be found to be in breach of any of the terms and conditions.
